Consultations

Keeping abreast of current political and legislative issues is paramount if CPI is to lobby effectively on behalf of Members. We respond to all relevant Government consultations where Members are canvassed for their views.

CPI has built a considerable network of relationships within UK Government and its Departments, and with MPs with Member companies within their constituencies. Our experienced staff ensure that Government is kept aware of the industry's achievements as well as its concerns.

CPI maintains good levels of communications with MPs, ensuring that CPI Members' interests are represented throughout Parliament. We produce an MPs newsletter informing MPs about the range of issues currently affecting the competitiveness of our Members. The newsletter is issued at the beginning of each parliamentary session to over 600 MPs.
